Substance Abuse Testing

HealthCARE Express staff is certified by DATIA to drug and alcohol tests. We offer a wide variety of testing, including urine, nail and breath testing.

5 Panel Urine Drug Test:

Tests for marijuana, amphetamines, opiates, PCP, cocaine.

9 Panel Urine Drug Test:

Tests for marijuana, amphetamines, opiates, PCP, cocaine, methamphetamines, benzodiazepines, barbiturates and methadone.

Hair Tests:

Hair testing can detect drug use for the previous 90 days.

Nail Tests:

Nail testing can detect drug use for the previous 8 months.

In addition to the tests listed here, HealthCARE Express can also test for other substances or create specific panels to meet your needs.

On-Site Testing:

We offer on-site drug testing, saving companies money lost from down time while an employee is away from the workplace taking a drug test. Advanced scheduling is required for this service.

Quick Drug Screens:

These tests provide results in less than 10 minutes. Non-negative tests are sent to the laboratory for confirmation testing. These tests are convenient for employers that need to have immediate test results. These tests are not available to employers that fall under federal testing program guidelines.

Breath Alcohol Testing:

Certified Breath Alcohol Technicians are on-staff to provide DOT and non-DOT breath alcohol tests. We utilizes the Intoxilyzer 400 to provide accurate alcohol testing.

Random Selection:

We will maintain an employee database for your company or organization and randomly select employees for testing. This reduces the company or organization liability, as the employer is removed from the selection process.

Nail Drug Testing

For almost 30 years, labs have been able to use fingernails and toenails to detect substance abuse use. However, the recent rise in the need for longer detection periods of substance abuse use has given nail testing a new priority.

Fingernails and toenails are composed of a hard protein called keratin. Drugs are incorporated into nails from the blood stream and remain locked in the nails as they grow. Drugs enter the nail from (1) the base as keratin is formed and (2) via the nail bed that extends under the full length of nail. HealthCARE Express screens nails for drug use with a five panel, Enzyme Multiple Immunoassay Test (EMIT). The fingernail is put in a chemical solution to rid the nail of external contaminants and is then liquefied.

How far does it go back?

Drugs can be identified in nail clippings for 2-4 weeks following ingestion and can be detected up to 8 months after last usage. Fingernails grow approximately 3-5 mm per month, toenails grow at a much slower rate of 1 mm per month which means that drugs can possibly appear in toenail clippings over 1 year after ingestion.

What drugs can be identified?

Marijuana (THC)
Methamphetamine
Amphetamine
Cocaine
Opiates
Phencyclidine (PCP)

Allow 7 days for results.
